

UNC School of Law Pro Bono Program Contract

Thank you for signing up for a pro bono project. By signing up for a project, you have agreed to the following provisions:

A. I will stay in touch with relevant Pro Bono Board members and with my supervising attorney. This means that if I have trouble getting in touch with my attorney, I will let the appropriate Pro Bono Board member know. During the course of the project, if I have a problem that I need to discuss with the attorney, I will contact the attorney to let them know about it.

- B. I will keep confidential any information regarding the cases on which I am working and discuss them only with my supervising attorney and anyone expressly authorized by my supervising attorney.
- C. I will take deadlines seriously. If I cannot meet a deadline, I will communicate this information to my supervising attorney as well as to the appropriate Pro Bono Board member.
- D. I agree to keep an accurate time record and log my pro bono hours upon completion according to the Student Pro Bono Handbook.
- E. I agree to act in a professional manner and in compliance with State Bar regulations and other Rules of Professional Conduct, as well as the Student Pro Bono Handbook. I agree to contact the Pro Bono Program Student Director or Director of Pro Bono Initiatives, Meghan Moran, if I have any questions about confidentiality, ethics, or the substance of my case.
- F. By signing up for a pro bono project, I understand that I am a reflection of the UNC School of Law Pro Bono Program. I understand that, unless extenuating or emergency circumstances arise, breaking a commitment to participate in a pro bono project is unprofessional. Doing so, especially if done without contacting a member of the Pro Bono Board and the supervising attorney, may require a meeting with Meghan Moran, Director of Pro Bono Initiatives.
